Our newsletter is full of information that we hope you find useful.

Labelling

Please label all of your child's belongings. This is extremely important with lunchboxes, as we have children within the nursery with severe allergies and lots of lunch boxes of the same design.

Holidays

Our holiday year runs from 1st January to 31st December. Your child is entitled to two weeks holiday of their usual pattern of attendance, at half fees. Where possible, we would appreciate notice being given of any holiday taken. Holiday request forms are available on the hall desk.



Nursery Closures

We will no longer be closing for two weeks at the end of August. The nursery will however be shut for one day, on Friday, 1st September, 2017, and we will also close for two weeks over Christmas each year.

Beanie Link Books

As some of you are already aware, at Bouncing Beans we are trying to build links with other provisions that your child attends. We believe that this link is a very important way to provide a consistent approach to your child's learning. If your child attends more than one child care provision (including child minders or nannies) please let us know so that we can set up a link book that each provision can write in to communicate with each other.

Tapestry

We have been using Tapestry from the start of term and we have received several positive comments. Some parents have not yet activated their accounts. Please see Michaela if you are unable to do this.

Lots of you have started to add your own observations of your children at home and this is lovely to see. We have enjoyed reading your comments on our observations, some of these have helped us to plan further activities to enhance your child's learning and development. Please continue to keep sharing these with us.

Outside play area

Equipment has been gradually arriving since the beginning of September, and our outside area is finally starting to come together!

Action Play & Leisure will be starting the installation of our new play tower, artificial grass and play hut on Tuesday, 11th October. There may be some disruption with outside play while this is happening, but it should only take two or three days to complete.

During the installation of the equipment, your child's safety remains our priority. All of the Action Play & Leisure team are DBS checked, and are experienced in working within schools and nurseries. The area will be fenced off, and the children will not be able to gain access until the work is completed.

Parents' Evening

This term we will not be holding a parents' evening. However, if you would like to discuss any worries, concerns or any matters regarding your child's learning and development, then we will gladly arrange a time for you to come in and talk to your child's key person.

Unwell children

Your child should not be brought into nursery if he/she is unwell. We would be very grateful if you could inform us of their absence before 9.15am. A 48 hour exclusion period is maintained for sickness and diarrhoea, taken from the last episode, to prevent the illness spreading to others.

Antibiotics

It is important that children are not subjected to the rigours of the nursery day when they have first become ill and require a course of antibiotics. It is also vital that the child is with their main carer in the first 24 hours in case they suffer a reaction to the medication. It is therefore our policy to exclude children for the first 48 hours of the course.
